As we approach the celebration of Our Lord's Nativity, I am profoundly grateful for all that we have accomplished together as a parish community this year. Our parish hall refurbishment was completed and commissioned by His Excellency the Papal Nuncio. The hall is now at our disposal for the service of the community. The Archdiocese recognised our parish's contribution to Catholic life in Barnes and beyond, for which two of our parishioners were awarded the Archdiocesan Merit Award. At Easter, five adults were received into full communion and baptised, and a record number of children received their First Holy Communion. Another record number of teenagers have registered for Confirmation next year, and we have welcomed several new members throughout the year. The school continues to feature prominently in parish life.

I am deeply grateful to all who offer their time and service so generously: those who clean and care for the church, our flower arrangers, the choir and musicians, altar servers and Masters of Ceremonies, Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist, lectors, members of the Finance Committee, and the Social Events Committee.
